How to pray for Argentina

The population of Argentina is around 44 million with about 5% percent Evangelical Christians. Pray for:

1. Conviction—for the lost to feel the conviction of the Holy Spirit and turn from their sins (John 16:8-11; 2 Cor 7:10)
2. Leadership—our church leadership is essential for continued growth - pray for leaders to *train, disciple* and *release* others into ministry.
3. Harvest—for salvation to come to many around the country and for their involvement in the local church.
4. Vision & Support for university ministry—pastors and church leaders need to catch the vision for reaching university students for Christ and initiate outreach towards the university campus.
5. Evangelism—for believers to be bold and unashamed to speak about Jesus. (Acts 4:23-31)
